

Collecting and Purchasing Books

Over 775 books have been donated to date. Many are newly purchased books, but some are gently used. Books will be purchased with a goal of delivering books bags four times a year to the Crisis Nursery Center in Urbana, IL during the first year. Books will be purchased through wholesale book companies.

Our First Distribution

On October 2, 155 book bags with 5 books were given to the Crisis Nursery Center in Urbana, IL. The books were leveled appropriate to the ages of the children. The Crisis Nursery creates an "island of safety" dedicated to the prevention of child abuse and neglect by providing 24-hour emergency care for children and support to strengthen families in crisis. Crisis Nursery is the only emergency-based child care facility open 24 hours, 365 days a year for the entire community to access with no fees or income eligibility. It focuses on children birth to age six.

Special thanks to our wonderful friends and family who have enabled Books From Brek to get off the ground.

Jessica McCann, Program Coordinator at the Crisis Nursery Center shared the following story: "Seven moms at my support group last night received age appropriate books for their children who might not otherwise be able to afford new books like this. This gave them a boost in confidence being able to provide an educational piece for their child. One mom, who is expecting, found a renewed joy in receiving books for her new baby. How neat we are fostering reading to her baby before the baby arrives."
